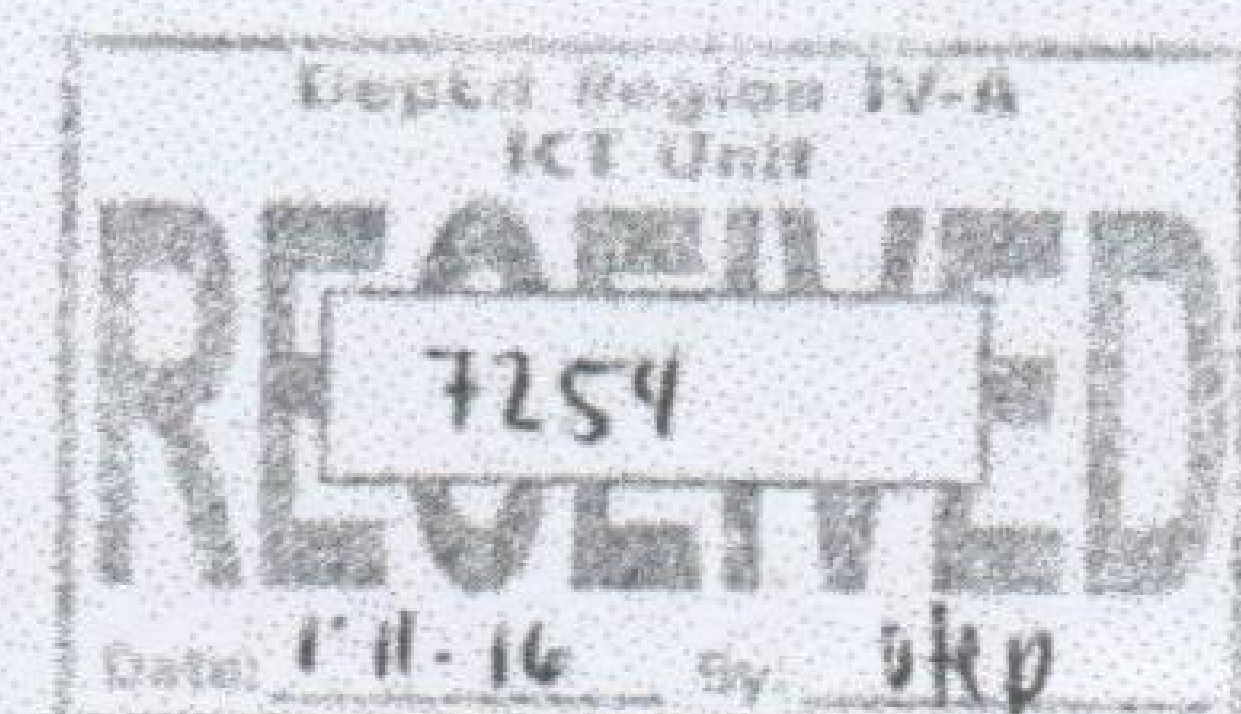

Step 1: Choose from the 3 Cohorts:

US Study Tour Cohort 2A: K-12 Special Education Teachers (May 15 – 25, 2016)

US Study Tour Cohort 2B: K-12 Science and Math Teachers (May 23 – June 1, 2016)

US Study Tour Cohort 2C: IB with Inclusion Program (June 12 – June 22, 2016)

Step 2: Download TTG Application form.

Step 3: Submit duly accomplished form to ttgstudytour2016@theteachersgallery.com on or before January 15, 2016. Due to the limited slots, application will be processed on a first come, first served basis.

Step 4: Accepted applicants will receive an email confirmation by February 1, 2016.

Step 5: Qualified applicants will be scheduled for a group visa interview as well as visa coaching. Our travel agency partner will be responsible for submitting the US Application Form DS-160 and payment of the visa application fee of US\$160.00. Applicants will be requested to fill in the information on the DS -160 and deposit the visa application fee to our bank accounts:

Step 7: Wait for updates re visa interview coaching and other announcements re the study tour program.

Step 8: All visas will be released to The Teacher's Gallery. Applicants will be asked to pay the Study Tour Fee upon visa approval which would include the purchase of Round Trip tickets from Manila to Boston, accommodations, school visits and the 5 day East Coast Tour.
