

This is also a must-course for Troop Leaders who wish to be Credentialed GSP Trainers. |

BASIC ADMINISTRATION For Administrators, District Committee and Barangay Committee | APRIL 20-22 | PRINCIPALS, SCHOOL ADMINISTRATORS/ DIRECTORS, DISTRICT COMMITTEE MEMBERS, BARANGAY COMMITTEE MEMBERS. | Php3,800.00 Dormitory-living | This course is intended to give the participants a deeper understanding and appreciation of the ways of work of the Movement and to stimulate more support and cooperation from them. |
| 5. STAR HOLIDAY COURSE | APRIL 20-22 | TEACHER / TROOP LEADERS who are handling Star Troops and intending to organize Star Troops. | Php3,800.00 Tent-living | At the end of this special course, the trainees are expected to have a deeper knowledge and demonstrate Star Holiday (camp) skills; learn more GSP Star Basic Songs and Games. |

THINGS TO BRING:


- personal stuff, GSP uniforms, low-heeled black shoes, physical fitness attire

- tent if possible.


Additional things to bring for CPC and OLC are:
