

Through its interdependent division for educational services, the International Mind Education Institute (IMEI) in cooperation with the local offices of the Department of Education, IYF Philippines will be holding the "2016 International Mind Education Specialist Training" at SM City Marikina, Cinema 4 on May 12 to 14, 2016 with participants from the city of Antipolo.
