The seminar aims to acquaint regular and special education teachers on strategies in addressing behaviors of children with autism and ADHD in the classroom.


Participants to this training/workshop are regular teachers, SPED teachers and school administrators.



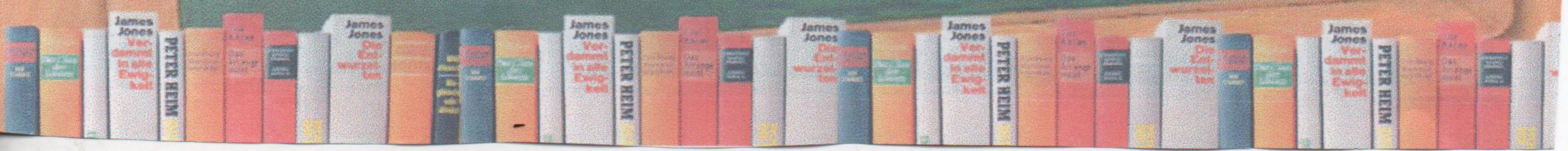
