



General Guidelines

- 1. The quiz bee is open to Grade 10 students.
- 2. Each school may send a maximum of two (2) teams. Each team is composed of two students of any gender combination (male-male, female-female or female-male).
- 3. Participating schools must pre-register by sending their registration forms by e-mail, fax or hand-carry on or before February 8, 2016.
- 4. On the contest proper, registration is from 8:00-8:30 am. Only registered teams will be allowed to join.

Quiz Bee Proper

- 1. The topics shall cover the following:
 - a. Elementary Algebra,
 - b. Intermediate Algebra,
 - c. Trigonometry,
 - d. Basic Statistics and Probability, and
 - e. Geometry
- 2. All participating teams will be given a chalk, board, and scratch paper. The quiz bee will have three rounds.

Round	No. of Items	Point System	Time Limit
Easy	10	1 point	10 seconds
Average	10	3 points	20 seconds
Difficult	10	5 points	30 seconds

- 3. The usage of calculator is prohibited.
- 4. The score from the three rounds will be tallied to determine the first, second, and third place winners.
- 5. In case of tie, clincher questions will be administered.

Clarifications

Clarifications on the question can only be raised by the coaches to the panel of judges. The head of the panel has the sole right to pronounce a question void. No questions or clarifications will be entertained after posting the next question or replacement of it.

Prize

All participants and coaches will be awarded with certificates. Winning teams, coaches, and school will be awarded with medals, plaques, and trophies respectively.
