4. Teacher/Principal/PTA advisers or co-advisers have to be designated by the concerned school.



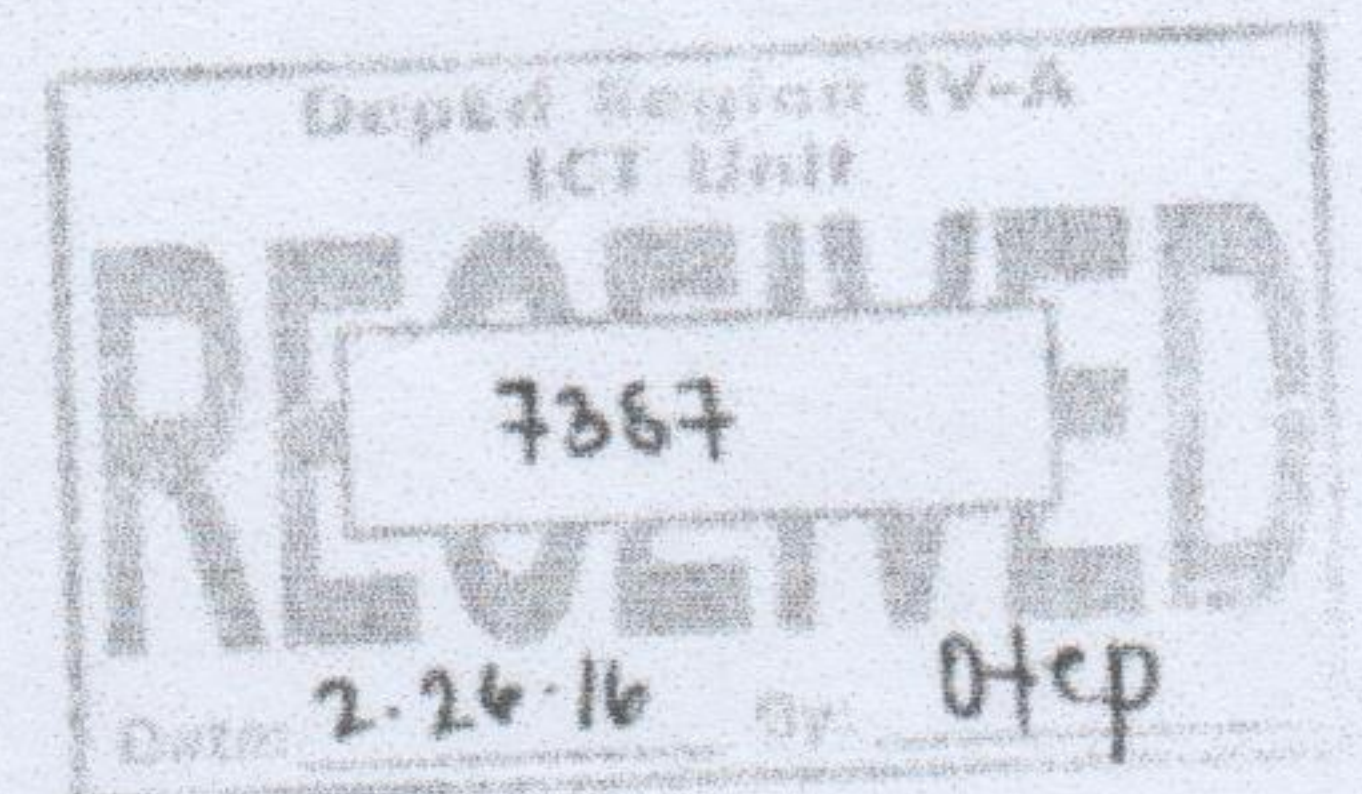
Warm solidarity greetings on behalf of the Lions Club International (LCI) District 301-A2.




