

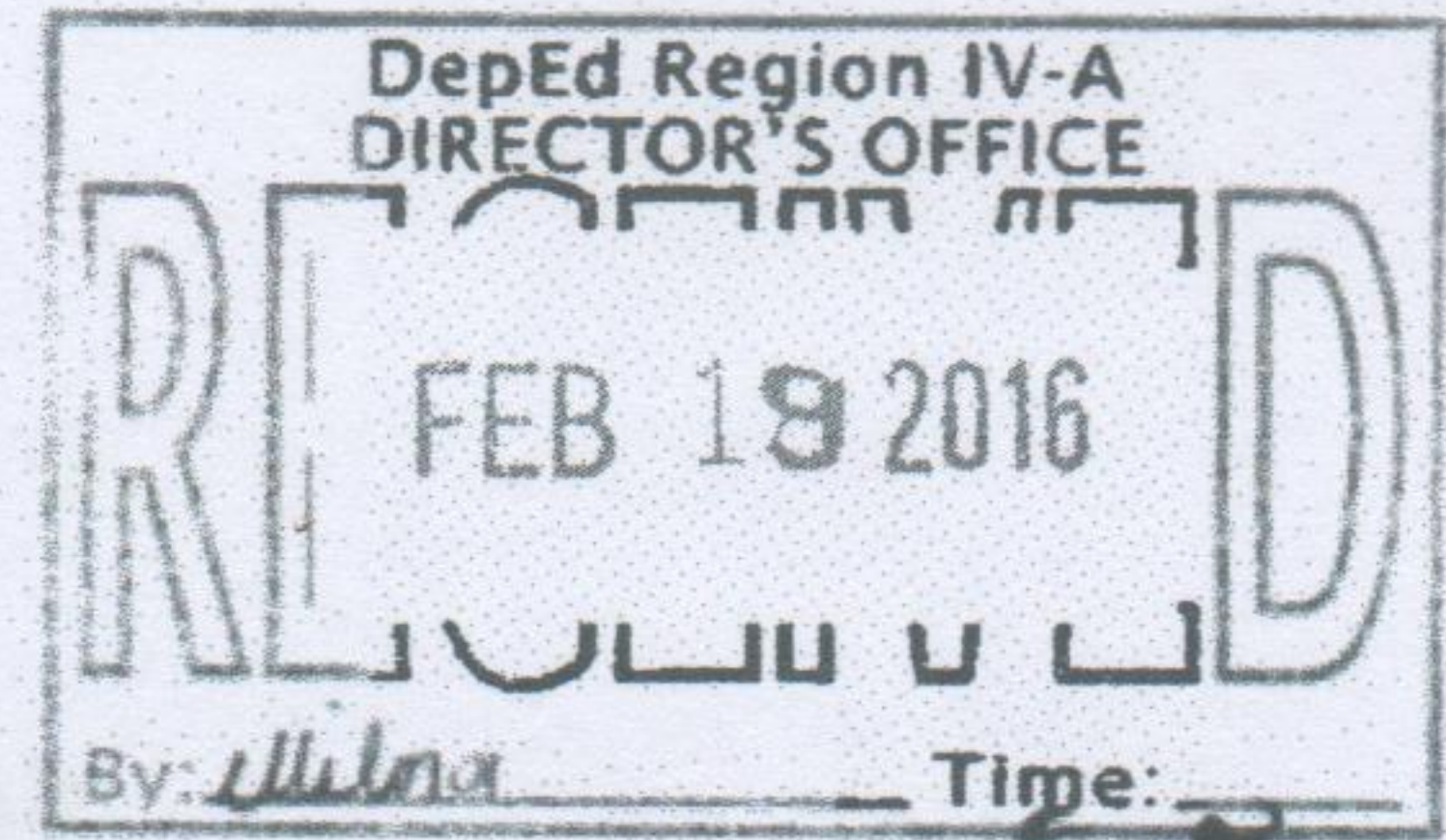
The target participants are the school administrators, guidance counselors and child protection officers from both public and private elementary and secondary schools.

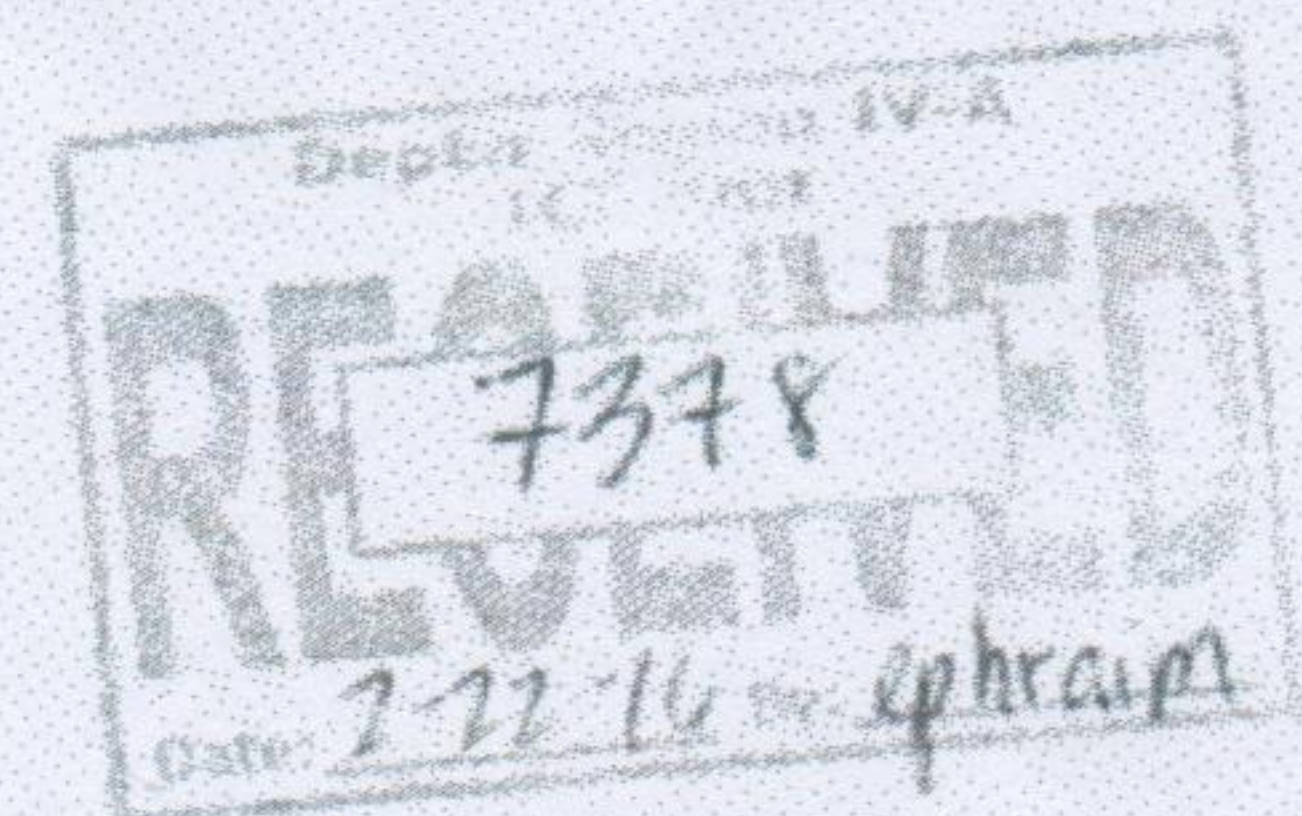

Withdrawal Policy
