

DIVISION MEMORANDUM No. 17 s. 2016 January 27, 2016

FIRST AID AND BASIC LIFE SUPPORT TRAINING FOR DISASTER RISK REDUCTION AND MANAGEMENT (DRRM) COORDINATORS

1. Pursuant to Republic Act (RA) No. 10121 entitled The Philippine Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Act of 2010, mandates all national government agencies to institutionalize policies, structures, coordination mechanisms and programs with continuing budget appropriation on Disaster Risk Reduction and Management (DRRM) from national to local levels. DepEd Order No. 50, s.2011 entitled Creation of Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Office (DRRMO), mandates the said office to initiate and spearhead the establishment of mechanisms which prepare, guarantee protection and increase resiliency of the Department of Education (DepEd) constituents in the face of disaster and to institutionalize the culture of safety at all levels, to systematize protection of education investments and to ensure continued delivery of quality education services.

The Division Disaster Risk Reduction and Management (DDRRM) in compliance with Deped Order No. 50 s.2015 shall capacitate school DRRM Coordinators through First Aid & Basic Life Support Training, as one of their essential functions of reducing risk and hazards in the school and in the workplace. DRRM Coordinators shall be guided on how to properly act in the advent of disasters that will help limit loss of lives and damage to properties. To mitigate and reduce the impact of disasters to DepEd teaching/non-teaching personnel/staff, learners and properties and to ensure the capacity to response to hazards, the schools division will conduct a three day training for school DRRM coordinators on First Aid and Basic Life Support on February 17-19, 2016 at Mayamot National High School.

2. The training aims to:

- a. Capacitate School DRRM Coordinators by enhancing their skills in providing first aid and basic life support;
- b. Provide guidance to schools & School DRRM Coordinators on how to act before, during and after disasters; and
- c. Orient School DRRM Coordinators on how to facilitate immediate and efficient information flow during disasters and emergencies.
- 3. Participants to this roll out are the School DRRM Coordinators and Assistant School DRRM Coordinators. They are requested to bring their copy of their action plan and necessary data for Mid and Long Term Plan development and a laptop.
- 4. A registration fee of Php 1,050.00 will be charged each participant to defray expenses for food for 3 days, training kit and training materials. Such registration shall be charged against the School's Local Fund subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and procedures.
