
- Pursuant to DepEd Memorandum No. 141, s. 2015, the Metrobank Foundation Inc. (MBFI) and the Mathematics Teachers Association of the Philippines (MTAP) hereby announce the conduct of the 2016 Metrobank-MTAP-DepEd Math challenge from January to March 2016.
- 2. The overall objective of this competition is to contribute in improving the quality of education in our country, specifically, it aims to:
  - a. awaken greater interest in Mathematics among elementary and secondary school students in both public and private schools;
  - b. encourage students to strive for excellence in Mathematics;
  - c. encourage mastery of basic mathematical skills;
  - d. discover mathematical talents among students;
  - e. develop the values of hard work, perseverance, honesty, teamwork, and sportsmanship; and
  - f. provide them with the opportunities in leadership and cooperative undertaking.
- 3. The Elimination round will be conducted at the different designated venues on Thursday, January 14, 2016 for elementary level and Friday, January 15, 2016 for secondary level from 7:00 AM to 12:00 NN. This will be participated in by top three (3) contestants from Grades I-VI and Grade 7-10 from forty three (43) complete public elementary schools, twenty two (22) public secondary schools (including STEM and Science High School), twenty three (23) private elementary and twenty three (23) private secondary schools.

#### MECHANICS FOR THE ELIMINATION ROUND


- 1. Every grade level is composed of top three students of both elementary and secondary schools.
- 2. All selected students per grade level in each school will take written test in a place or center designated by the Division. The test materials shall be provided by MTAP.
- 3. Students should register by grade level indicating their full name, school, district and division.
- 4. All students will write their name and school on the test paper. (Names will facilitate the identification of the students).
- 5. Students will be given scratch papers to solve the problems. Only answers are to be written on the test paper.


6. The duration of the test is as follows:

Grade Level	Time Allotment
Grades I - 2	60 minutes
Grades 3 - 4	80 minutes
Grades 5 - 6	100 minutes
Grades 7 - 10	2 hours

- 7. Students from the same school must not sit beside each other or one behind the other. A school must not have more than 3 contestants per grade level.
- 8. All papers should be collected when the time is up.
- 9. The test papers will be corrected immediately using the keys provided, which will be opened just before correction begins. Each correct answer merits one point.
- 10. Staple together the papers of the students of each school per grade level with the school score written at the top of the first paper.
- 11. The scores of the top two contestants of a school by grade level shall be added to form the school's score. Suppose the scores of the three contestants of School A in Grade I are as follows:

- The score of the School A will be 35 + 38 = 73. The Grade I team from School A will be composed of Jose and Rosa.
- Assuming School A qualifies to compete in the Division Team Finals, Efren will be the alternate if either Rosa or Jose is not available on the date of the competition.
- In case, both Jose and Rosa are not available to compete due to unforeseen circumstances, Efren will not be allowed to compete alone. Thus, their team will automatically be disqualified. <u>SUBSTITUTION IS NOT ALLOWED.</u>
- 12. The school scores of the whole division per grade level shall be ranked from highest to lowest.
- 13. The top 6 to 20 highest scoring schools may be qualified to participate in the Division Team Final competition. There shall be no cut-off score. The number of the teams qualified to join the Division Finals is dependent on the number of participating schools in the elimination rounds. Please refer to the matrix below:





NOTE: 20 is the maximum number of teams because experience indicates that it is the number manageable to an oral team competition.

- 14. The top individual scorers of the whole division, one for Grade 6 and one for Grade 10 are qualified to compete in the Regional Individual Finals.
- 15. The Division Qualifiers for the Division Team Finals (top 2 scorers of qualified school) will be announced through Division Bulletin.







## GUIDELINES FOR PROCTORS ELIMINATION ROUND

- Make sure all the students have registered. Make them write their name and school on the test paper (this will facilitate the identification of the students). Students of the same grade must be in the same room for the test. Two or more rooms may be used for one (1) grade level if the number of the participants could not be accommodated in one (1) room.
- Make sure all students are in place before distributing the test questions. Do not allow students of the same school to sit beside each other or one behind the other. Make sure there is sufficient distance between students.
- 3. Give the students scratch paper to solve the problems. Only answers are WRITTEN on the question sheet.
- 4. Distribute the papers face downwards. Tell them to pass the papers only when you have given the papers for all the rows at the first student on the row.
- 5. Tell the students not to begin answering the questions until you give the signal. The time starts when you give the signal to begin so they should not be in a hurry, but ask for any needed clarifications. Clarifications here mean clarifying any word that may not be well printed but no explanations of the questions should be given. Any indicated corrections are to be given before the students begin the test. All clarification must be done before the students answer the questions. If necessary, read for the Grades I and II. No more questions may be asked when the students have started answering the test.
- 6. Tell them that all questions must be addressed to you before beginning the test.
- 7. Duration for test:

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Grades 1 - 2	60 minutes
Grades 3 - 4	80 minutes
Grades 5 - 6	100 minutes
Grades 7 - 10	2 hours

- 8. If any student submits before the time, accept it and ask the students to leave the room. Collect ALL papers when the time is up. Do not allow any continuation.
- 9. Check all the test papers accurately after the test is finished.
- 10. Submit the results of the test to the Principal Consultant In-charge of each grade level.








