



Please be informed that there will be **Antipolohenyo Essay Writing Contest** initiated by **Hon. Roberto V. Puno**, representative of District I of Antipolo City. The said contest will replace the Puno Leadership Award and aims to give more opportunities for deserving public school students in Antipolo City's 1st District to be recognized and rewarded for their exceptional skills. All public elementary and secondary schools in the said district will conduct the essay writing contest on the 4th week of February (February 22-26, 2016). The first prize winner in each school will be their entry for the district level which will be submitted on February 29, 2016 c/o **Mrs. Victorina Yuson**, Public Schools District Supervisor (PSDS), DepEd Antipolo City. The announcement of winners for the district level contest will be on March 2, 2016.

Besides the Antipolohenyo Essay Writing Contest, Puno Award of Excellence for Outstanding Teachers and Puno Award for Special Achievement for students will also be given to continue the usual annual awards and recognition by the said proponent with slight modifications to adjust to the K-12 Curriculum. Submission of the name of awardees together with other attachments to the abovementioned PSDS will be on or before March 4, 2016.

Attached are the letters and guidelines from the Office of Hon. Roberto V. Puno, Deputy Speaker, House of Representatives for your reference.

Mechanics for the "AntipolHENYO ESSAY WRITING CONTEST"

Eligibility requirements:

1. All graduating students for the current school year (2015-16) in the Elementary and Grade 10 students enrolled in the public schools of Antipolo City's 1st district are qualified to join the Contest.

2. Children and/or wards of employees and officials of the Department of Education-Antipolo, and their relatives up to the second degree of consanguinity or affinity are disqualified from joining the contest.

Mechanics:

1. The essay contest shall be entitled:

"AntipolHENYO ESSAY WRITING CONTEST"

With a theme:

Kung ikaw ay pagkakalooban ng "3 wishes" na puwede ang kahit anong bagay,
anu-ano ang hihilingin mo?
walang tama o maling sagot, kaya't maging tapat at makatotohanan sa iyong
kasagutan.

Tandaan na ito ay essay writing contest, kaya't paghusayan ang paglalahad ng
iyong paliwanag.

- 2. Announcements about the essay-writing contest will be disseminated through the DepED Antipolo Office and all participating schools from the 1st District, Antipolo City.
- 3. The Contest will take place during a subject period so that all qualified students can participate. The alloted time for the subject period may be extended, if necessary, to accommodate the time for preparation and the Contest Proper.
- 4. The essay must be original and should expound on the themes (for your approval of theme)
- 5. The essay should not be less than 400 words but not more than 600 words and may be written in either Filipino or English.
- 6. The use of mobile phones and other electronic devices is strictly prohibited during the Contest.
- 7. The teacher-advisers will choose the top essay for each Section of the Elementary Graduating Batch in each school and from each Section of the Grade 10 batch in each school
- 8. All selected entries will be judged by the teachers from the ENGLISH and/or FILIPINO Department.
- 9. One winner in the Elementary Category and one winner in the Grade 10 level will be chosen in each School and will represent the school in the district-wide selection to be conducted by DepEd Antipolo personnel
- 10. In choosing the Grand Prize (district-wide) Winners, the participant's name, school and other contact details must not appear in the submitted entry, for purposes of anonymity and objectivity. Only a control number should appear on the submitted entry. The DepEd and concerned School is tasked to keep its list accurate to ensure that the control numbers corresponds to the submitted entries of the participants.

- 11. No distinguishing mark should appear in the entry. Only the control number which corresponds to the name in the entry shall be written on the top right portion of the essay.
- 12. All winners are required to sign a form stipulating that the submitted entries shall become the property of the Office of Deputy Speaker Roberto V. Puno. By participating in this contest, the writer grants to the sponsors and organizers the right without the need of payment, other than the prize which may have been awarded: to publish from time to time or quote as it may at its discretion; to edit the work or any portion thereof suitable for publication; and/or to make the works available on the internet or other electronic media. Any essay/s to be used in that way would be done so with proper attribution to the writer.
- 13. Judges selected by, or representing DepEd-Antipolo, shall draw up the criteria for selecting the winning essays in each school and in naming the Grand Prize Winners. The judges' decisions are final.
- 14. The awarding of prizes and trophies for the School Winners in both divisions and the Grand Prize (district-wide) Winners will be held during the Graduation/Recognition rites.
- 15. The sponsors and organizers reserve the right to nullify and/or cancel any part of the competition if it appears that any fraud or plagiarism have occurred in any form.
- 16. The winner chosen for each school shall receive the following:

For the Elementary Category: Php3, 000.00 with medal and certificate

For the Grade 10 Category: Php3, 000.00 with medal and certificate

17. The Grand Prize (district-wide) winners will receive the following:

For the Elementary Category: Ipad with plaque

For the Grade 10 Category: Ipad with plaque
