3. plan for the re-echo of oral health key messages to co-teachers in respective schools.

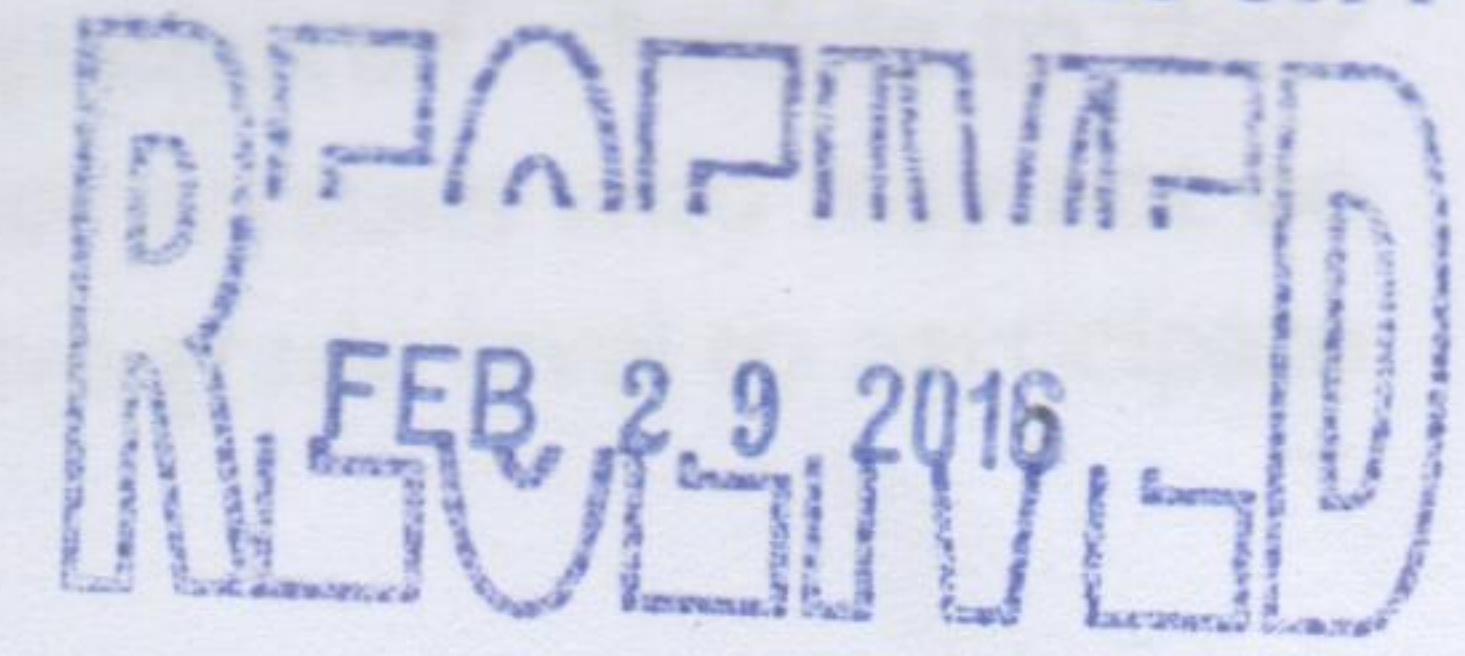


