- 1.1 to instill in the hearts of every Filipino the importance of maintaining good oral health in relation to their general wellness
- 1.2 to give an idea about the effect of the food taken to their oral health.
- 1.3 to show the talents of Elementary and Secondary students with an in depth interpretation of the National Dental Health Month through their skills
- 2.2 strengthen public awareness on the importance of the good oral health.

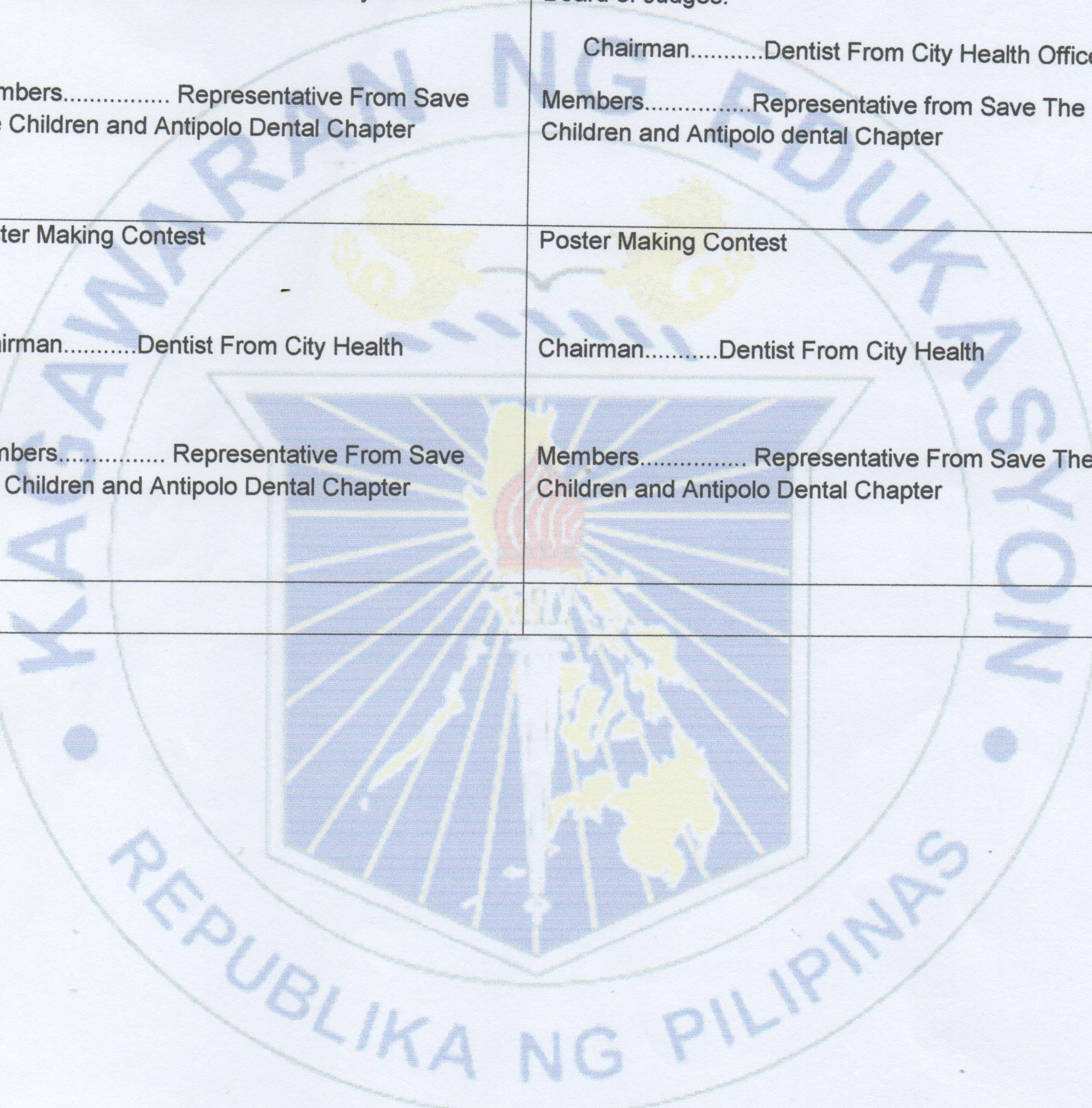

Rules and Regulation

A. Elementary Level/Secondary Level

Poster making Contest:

Mechanics

1. An on- the -spot Poster Making Contest for grade IV to grade VI pupil
2. Only one (1) pupil will represent his/her school.
3. The contestant/ pupil should use ¼ Illustration Board only
4. The contestant/ pupil can use cray pass, pastel, water color or crayon as a medium in coloring.
5. A criteria on judging should be based on relevance to the theme, color or design harmony, originality of the thought and speed.

Color Harmony	20%
Originality	20%
Speed	20%

B. Secondary Level

Jingle Making Contest

Mechanics

1. It should be a choral group pattern using any kinds of indigenous and note electronically played musical instruments played in 2 to 3 minutes only. (15 participants maximum)
2. Show combination pattern, chants, musicality and clean execution of the jingle regardless of musicality style.
3. The group should provide original lyrics of their music
4. No need to have a fabulous costumes and props

Criteria for Judging

Harmony of Tone	20%
Originality	20%
Musicality (indigenous Instruments)	25%
Audience Impact	5 %
Time	5%
Total	100%

SABAYANG PAGBIGKAS

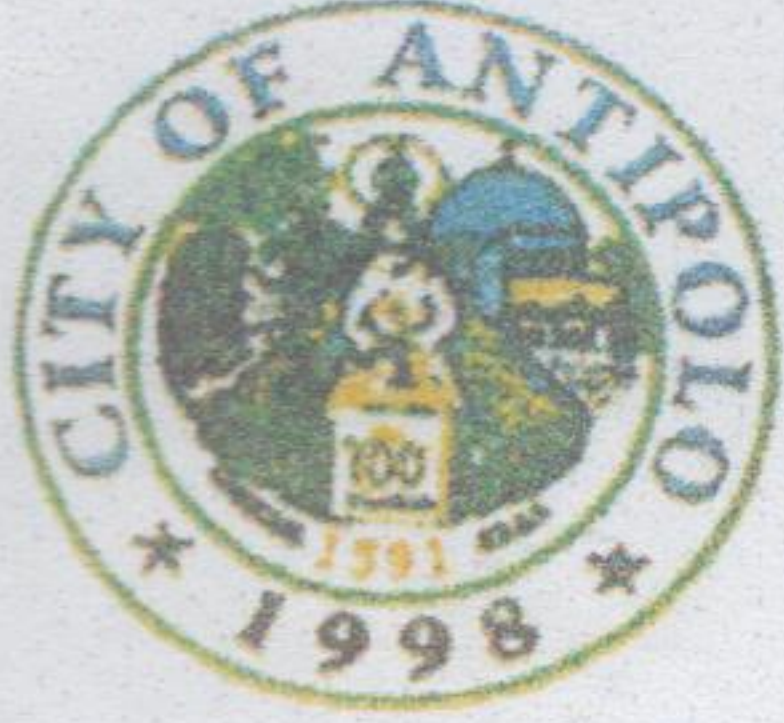
Mechanics:

1. The contest is open to all public elementary schools.
2. The participants/group shall be composed of 20. Members of the group could come from Grade 4 to Grade 6.
3. Each group shall be given the opportunity to create their own piece. It should be relevant to the theme of National Dental Health Month and Oral Health key messages (attached in this mechanics).

Theme: ***“Kalinisan ng Ngipin lagging Panatilihin, Ugaliing Kumain ng Masusustansyang Pagkain.”***

4. The time element of the contest shall be 3 to 4 minutes.
5. The first syllable/word uttered signals the start of the performance, and the last syllable/word determines the end of performance.
6. The decision of the board of judges is final and irrevocable.


***"Kalinisan ng Ngipin laging Panatilihin,
