
VILLAR SIPAG (SOCIAL INSTITUTE FOR POVERTY ALLEVIATION & GOVERNANCE)

As part of the advocacy of the Villar SIPAG to alleviate the poverty situation in the country, it has established a farm school which serves as a learning hub for capacity building of communities to survive, adapt and thrive in the demands of agriculture. It has already catered to more than 400 students who get free agricultural trainings for their personal growth and technical know – how.

One of the training partners, Allied Botanical Corporation, will launch its 2nd batch of vegetable farming training on March 10, 2016. 8:00 AM at the Villar SIPAG Farm School. The regular weekly training starts every Wednesday (March 16) for the next 3 months. Most topics being covered in the training are: land preparation, liquid fertilizer making, pest control, mulching, plant nutrition, transplanting, harvesting, etc. The training is being held at the Villar SIPAG Farm School, at San Nicolas I, Bacoor City, Cavite from 7 AM – 2 PM. Registration is FREE. NO cost or any charges shall be collected from the participants.
