



**ANNOUNCING THE CONDUCT OF ADMISSION TEST FOR THE  
ANTIPOLO CITY SCIENCE HIGH SCHOOL GRADE 7 ENTRANTS**

1. This is to announce the administration of the entrance examination to screen the Grade 7 applicants of Antipolo City Science High School for the SY 2015-2016 on Saturday, February 21, 2015 at Antipolo National High School, Olalia Rd. Brgy. Sta. Cruz, Antipolo City at exactly 8:00 o'clock in the morning.
  2. To qualify, the applicant must be:
    - A resident of Antipolo City
    - A grade 6 who is candidate for graduation from either public or private school in Antipolo City
    - Has grade not lower than 85% in all learning areas and with general weighted average of not lower than 85% in the third grading period
    - Certified by the School Head that he/she belongs to the upper 10% of the graduating class
    - Have special aptitude in Science, English and Mathematics
    - Physically fit and of good moral character.
  3. In addition, the applicant must submit the following:
    - duly accomplished application form (available at ANHS) with two pieces | X | recent identical pictures
    - photocopy of Form 137 duly certified by the School Head
    - Barangay Certificate of Residency.
  4. The applicants who qualify the admission test and interview should undergo physical/medical examination from any public physician, results of which should be submitted upon enrolment together with the NCSO birth certificate.
  5. The School Selection Committee, shall be headed by the Principal of Antipolo City Science High School and selected teachers shall serve as members who will administer, check the test and conduct interview. Result shall be submitted to the Division Office:
