#### CONTEST MECHANICS NATIONWIDE CREATIVE PAINTING CONTEST

- This contest is open to Out-of-School Youth (OSY) nationwide, ages 15 to 20, high school undergraduate and currently unemployed. The OSY should be included in the list of ALS-Regional/Division/Chapter of the Department of Education (DepEd).
- The theme of this year's competition is "Ipunia ang Kagitingan sa Kabataan, Ihanda ang Beterano ng Kinabukasan". It aims to increase awareness of the Araw Ng Kagitingan as a shining moment of courage and commitment to freedom by our WWII veterans
- 3. The contestant should submit two (2) similar paintings in a 20"x30" and 15"x20" illustration boards. Any medium can be used. Similar data should be placed in a 1/2 A-4 bond paper, computerized and be posted at the back of both paintings.

- The Philippine Flag should not be used as a background in the painting. If used as a part, it should be placed in a conspicuous place to show its importance to the art work (Please refer to Sec. 39 -Prohibited Acts of RA 8491).

- Accomplished entry form.
