4. All SPED Center/Schools who are interested may participate in the following activities;



1. Pursuant to Presidential Proclamation No. 711 entitled **Declaring the Third Week of January as Autism Consciousness Week** dated January 4, 1996 the Department of Education (DepEd) through the Special Education (SPED) Division, Bureau of Elementary Education (BEE), will celebrate the **19th National Autism Consciousness Week** with the theme *Autism Inclusive Philippines: Aim High Fly High* from January 25 to 31, 2015.


