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PANTAWID PAMILYA GWA POLICY

A guide document for partner teachers

PURPOSE OF THE DOCUMENT:

Starting school year 2015-2016, the implementation of the General Weighted Average (GWA) Policy of Pantawid Pamilyang Pilipino Program will be enforced. Thus, all children beneficiaries in HIGH SCHOOL by the end of the said school year must have a passing GWA prescribed by Department of Education, and/or be promoted to the next level. High school students who fail, and/or required to repeat a year level will NOT be allowed to continue as child beneficiaries of the program.

As part of the preparation of the program for the implementation of the GWA Policy, a revised Compliance Verification form (CV Form 2) will be used to capture the compliance of beneficiaries on the said policy. The revised CV Form 2 will provide Pantawid Pamilya a BASELINE DATA that will help the program to further improve the implementation of the GWA Policy.

This document will serve as a guide to our partner teachers, school heads, and principals on the revised CV Form 2.

WHAT WAS ADDED IN THE CV FORM 2?

The revised CV Form 2 now includes column number 9. This is applicable to children beneficiaries in HIGH SCHOOL only.

Instruction number 9 was also added in the revised CV Form 2 explaining how to properly fill out column number 9.

Shade the corresponding circle if the student failed or did not meet the DepEd GWA criteria and will not move on to the next year level.

REMEMBER:

- 1 The GWA Policy requires only the children beneficiaries in HIGH SCHOOL to pass the GWA prescribed by Department of Education
- 2 High school students who fail to meet the required GWA (for SY 2014-2015) will still be ALLOWED to continue as children beneficiaries of the program
- 3 Pantawid Pamilya will use the compliance data (for SY 2014-2015) on the said policy as BASELINE DATA only to further improve its implementation
- 4 Starting SY 2015-2016, HIGH SCHOOL students who fail to meet the required GWA will no longer be monitored by the program

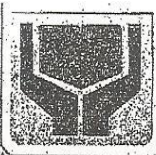

SUBJECT: Update on the General Weighed Average Policy

DATE: March 6, 2015

This is to provide you an update on the General Weighted Average Policy which was supposed to be implemented this school year 2014 – 2015. This policy is stipulated in Section 7: Repetition and Required General Weighted Average (GWA) of the NAC Resolution 18: Continued Support for the Child Beneficiaries of Pantawid Pamilyang Pilipino Program to Finish High School, which states that:

“children in elementary who repeat a year level in school are allowed to continue with the program. Children in highschool are required by the end of the school year to reach the passing General Weighted Average prescribed by DepEd, and/or promoted to the next year level”

To ensure the smooth implementation of this policy, the management has decided to defer the implementation of the GWA Policy to SY 2015-2016, taking into consideration the following concerns:

- 1) The need to test the IT systems for monitoring GWA;
- 2) The current open selection activity allows households to select the children that will be monitored, therefore GWA for highschool students might affect/influence the decisions of parents on which child they would select to be monitored by the program; and
- 3) The need to secure the support and commitment of partner agencies.

However, we will capture the GWA data for this current SY 2014 – 2015 which will serve as our baseline data. The baseline data will be analyzed for further improvement of the implementation of the said policy.

To be able to capture the GWA data we have modified CV Form 2 for P2 monitoring (March – April). We have attached sample CV Form 2 for your ready reference.

As part of our effort to strengthen the communication campaign about this policy, may we also provide you the guide documents for our Partners and Field officers as well as the communication to DepEd regarding this policy.

In connection to this, may we kindly request all FOs to cascade these changes to ensure that the said policy is properly communicated and understood to all concerned key partners, field officers as well as all concerned beneficiaries.

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
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
