Individual : Official GSP / Camping uniform

light beddings and sleeping bag or bed roll
sit-upon that are water resistant e.g. old tarpaulin, or plastic sack

Patrol : Tent for shelter and fly tent for kitchen
Food and drinking water supply
Stove (charcoal or super kalan)
