SUBJECT : **2015 Women’s Month Celebration**

DATE : March 3, 2015

Proclamation No. 224, s. 1988 and RA 6949 s. 1990 declares the first week of March each year as Women’s week and March 8 as Women’s Right and National Women’s Day respectively with the theme “JUANA, DESISYON MO AY MAHALAGA SA KINABUKASAN NG BAWAT ISA, IKAW NA!”

This year’s celebration pays tribute to all women leader who passionately led and continue to advance women’s advocacies. Their key roles and accomplishments in leadership, power and decision making will be highlighted in order to influence and break the consecutive mindset and belief that politics and leadership are not women’s world.

In view of the above and to ensure the success of the month-long celebration, all schools, elementary and secondary are enjoined to:

- a. Hang steamers *infront* of their school announcing the school’s participation in the campaign (see PCW website for specification/design of the streamer)
- b. Conduct Forum on Women in Leadership, Power and Decision Making: Why Women? Why Now? Why you?
- c. Conduct poster making in your school on the theme of Women’s History. Participant should illustrate the roles that women have played over the year.
- d. Host a “Women’s History Month”. Invite guests (local women) to talk about women in their inspiring history.

Expenses related to the 2015 National Women’s Month Celebration maybe charged to the GAD Budget.

A narrative report with pictorial should be submitted at the Division Office on or before April 6, 2015.

**MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR No. 2015-01**

**SUBJECT :** 2015 National Women's Month Celebration

**DATE :** 9 February 2015

Pursuant to Presidential Proclamation No. 224, 227 and Republic Act No. 6469, declaring first week of March as Women's Week, March 8 as National Women's Day, and providing for the observance of the month of March as "Women's Role in History Month", the Philippine Commission on Women (PCW), in coordination with the National Government Agencies (NGAs), Civil Society Organizations (CSOs), Local Government Units (LGUs) and State Universities and Colleges (SUCs) is spearheading the National Women's Month Celebration.

This year's theme "*Juana, Desisyon Mo ay Mahalaga sa Kinabukasan ng Bawat Isa, Ikaw Na!*" aims to pay tribute to all women leaders who passionately led and continue to advance women's advocacies. Their key roles and accomplishments in leadership, power and decision-making will be highlighted in order to influence and break the conservative mindset and belief that politics and leadership are not women's world.

The celebration will also be a perfect time to drum up the call for "Juanas" to run for public office since the last quarter of 2015 is the period for filing of candidacy for the 2016 election.

To promote public awareness in the observance of the event, all government agencies are encouraged to undertake the following activities:

- Organizing activities about the observance in your organization and partners;
- Submission to PCW of your organization's calendar of activities for the observance until February 25, 2015 and accomplishment reports until April 17, 2015;
- Hanging of 2015 NWMC official streamer in all government agencies, including regional offices, local government units, and Philippine embassies and consulates;
- Uploading of the official logo, advocacy video and other National Women's Month advocacy materials in government agencies' website, Facebook, YouTube and Twitter pages;
- Participation in the online campaign thread about the observance;





- Inclusion of 2015 National Women's Month Celebration materials in all agencies' publications/newsletters;
- Development of IEC materials for 2015 NWMC ;
- For NCR-based agencies / offices: participation in the 2015 NWMC Simultaneous Street Dance on March 8, 2015 at Quezon Memorial Circle, Quezon City and mobilizing as many delegates as possible;
- For regional / provincial offices and LGUs: coordinating with other government offices or LGUs in your area for inter-agency / LGU collaboration in holding a regional/local version of the National Women's Day Program and Simultaneous Street Dance Activity on March 8, 2015 (refer to Annex 1 for suggested program).
- Joining the nationwide Women's Month Photo Contest (visit [www.pcw.gov.ph](http://www.pcw.gov.ph) website for details);
- Attending the Forum on Women in Leadership, Power and Decision Making on March 24 (visit [www.pcw.gov.ph](http://www.pcw.gov.ph) for more details)
- Organizing a film showing activity in your respective agencies/LGUs (preferably BOSES film produced by ERASTO Film Productions);

All government agencies and LGUs are enjoined to participate in the Women's Month Celebration and to authorize the attendance of their employees in the 2015 NWMC Simultaneous Street Dance on official business time. Expenses related to the 2015 National Women's Month Celebration may be charged to the Gender and Development (GAD) Budget of government agencies.
