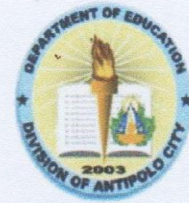


This Office has received a complaint against selling /endorsing of goods and other commodities or other business venture to teachers and other school personnel by DepEd Officials exercising their Official influence.

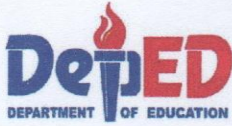
Along with this, the undersigned deemed it necessary to reiterate the strict implementation and compliance of the following laws, rules and regulations:

DepEd Order No. 41, s. 2012, paragraph 2, letter e

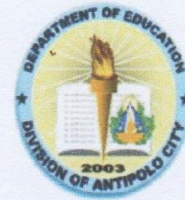

Teachers shall not act, directly or indirectly, as agent of any commercial venture, nor shall they be financially interested, of which they can exercise official influence. Hence, teachers, school officials and school personnel are prohibited from selling or requiring the purchase of locally-produced workbooks, instructional materials, test booklets, school supplies and other items (Underlining ours)

Section 3 of Republic Act 3019, letter h

XXX

(h) Directly or indirectly having financial or pecuniary interest in any business, contract or transaction in connection with which he intervenes or takes part in his official capacity, or in which he is prohibited by the Constitution or by any law from having any interest. (underlining ours)

Section 7 of Republic Act 6713, letter d

XXX

Public officials and employees shall not solicit or accept, directly or indirectly, any gift, gratuity, favor, entertainment, loan or anything of monetary value from any person in the course of their official duties or in connection with any operation being regulated by, or any transaction which may be affected by the functions of their office. (underlining ours)

XXX

Article X, Code of Conduct of Professional Teachers, Section 3

Section 3: No teacher shall act, directly or indirectly, as agent of, or be financially interested in any commercial venture xxx in the purchase and disposal of which he can exercise official influence, except only when his assignment is inherently related to such purchase and disposal. (underlining ours)

All officials of DepEd Antipolo City are reminded to deviate from commission of such acts to be free from administrative sanctions of **Abuse of Authority and Conduct Prejudicial to the Service**, and without prejudice to criminal and civil liabilities provided therein.
